Tasting Notes:

The wine expresses a lot of fresh red & black fruit aromas, layering a display of herbal and spicy notes. It is gentle on the pallet with a fresh, juicy, persistent finish.

Region: Maipú and Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza

Elevation: Average 960 meters ASL

Soil Composition: Made with grapes from vineyards located in

Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza.

Age of the vines: 30 years average

Winemaking:

Harvest: Grapes are manually harvested at optimal

ripeness. Once in the winery, bunch selection and

destemming are carried out.

Fermentation: Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks

at controlled temperatures with selected yeast. It is then aged for a period in a mix of concrete and stainless-steel tanks. The final blend is made with a

balance of both varietals.
